PLUMBERS INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Important Information

* All pipework must be thoroughly flushed prior to installation.

Installation (Fig.1)

- 1) Check that threaded nipple (2) is the correct length, as shown. Cut to length if required ensuring end face is square. Apply thread tape to the thread.
- 2) Select the desired cover plate (1) (round or square shape) and place over the threaded nipple (2), with the **Caroma** marking aligned horizontally at the bottom. Screw the spigot (3) onto the threaded nipple (2) using a 10mm allen key (4+) (not supplied) until the cover plate (1) is held securely against the wall/tile face. DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN. Apply suitable lubricant to 'O'Rings (5).

IMPORTANT

Pressure & Temperature Requirements.

- Hot and cold water inlet pressures should be equal.
- Static Inlet pressure range: 150 -1000 kPa New Regulation:- 500 kPa maximum static pressure at any outlet within a building. (Ref. AS/NZS 3500.1)
- Maximum hot water temperature : 80°C.
